

The 2021 season will have a new look both for NASCAR and Bay View. NASCAR has added more road courses and even a dirt race; they have also eliminated some tracks. At Bay View we have changed the system to 4 sheets instead of six, so you won't have to remember to get your sheets in on time as often. There will still be the same number of races, but you will pick more drivers on each sheet. This also has the advantage that you can't just keep picking the same six drivers every time, now you will have to pick 8 or nine (depending on the sheet).




