

Report from the Commodore



I would like to take this time to thank everyone that has helped out over the year with parties and events, you helped making the parties a success.


I am looking forward to taking over membership over the next year. If anyone has any ideas or advise on ways to increase membership please let me know.

Ice Skating on the Lagoon

As a member, I had spent the last 18 years trying to melt ice and preserve the docks as chairman of the aeration committee. As a kid, I spent many winter afternoons skating on the lagoon ice. Up until the 1970's there was no attempt to prevent the movement of the



dock poles due to ice heave. The wooden docks suffered greatly during the winter and much time and effort went into straightening things out in the spring. One good side effect of this neglect was the ability to ice skate during the winter. Our protected lagoon usually had very smooth and thick ice for most of the winter. On Sundays a group of 30 to 40 people would show up to skate at the club.

A mat was laid out from the old basement entrance (where the outdoor bathrooms are now) to the bulkhead and a ladder set up for access to the ice. There were ledges inside that old entrance where we would put on and remove our skates. My father had a portable record player that he would bring down and he would play "skating music" for the crowd. Folks would go back and forth from the ice to the bar to warm up and get refreshments.




