Members should be prepared to help all other members on the day that they pull their boat. Anyone wanting to work winter storage should report at 8:30am at the haul out shed.

Note: An application for winter storage must be filled out and signed before your boat will be pulled. The applications are at the bar.

Reminder from the Dock Water Committee

Dock holders are responsible for water hose leaks. Leaky hoses will be shut off if found during regular dock water inspections. Do Not Remove Backflow Devices when you change docks.

All trailers and sail boat cradles must have your name and phone number to be stored at BVYC.

Please remove all personal items including boat stands from the yard. We will be cleaning the area soon and removing items that do not belong in the yard. Members with dock boxes should abide by rule 21 which states that they should be over the water or against the fence, not in the stoned area of the yard
