Important Recall Notice

November 2, 2017

Dear Valued Customer:

Today, Kidde, in conjunction with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) announced a voluntary recall to replace certain Kidde fire extinguishers. To view the release, please visit www.kidde.com and click on "Product Safety Recall Notice."

As communicated to you in safety notices dated August 14, 2017 and October 5, 2017, Kidde has determined that certain fire extinguishers can become clogged or require excessive force to activate, posing a risk of failure to discharge. In addition, the nozzle can detach with enough force to pose an impact hazard. As a result, the affected units are being recalled.

This recall involves two styles of Kidde fire extinguishers: certain plastic handle fire extinguishers and pushbutton Pindicator fire extinguishers.

Plastic handle fire extinguishers: The recall involves 134 models of Kidde fire extinguishers manufactured between January 1, 1973, and August 15, 2017, including some models that were previously recalled in <u>March 2009</u> and in February 2015. The extinguishers were sold in red, white and silver, and are either ABC-or BC-rated. Models are as follows:
